GRADY-WHITE (MIBS)

The Fisherman 236 (23'7" LOA, 8'6" beam) redefines the 23-foot center console by incorporating fishing-with-family features and options into the design scheme. Seating includes bow seats with fold-away, forward-facing, bolstered backrests and a fold-away aft bench. Standard features include new, built-in swim platform extensions that double as boarding areas, starboard-side deck level anchor storage, a four step swim ladder, and

stand-up head area inside the console. For tow sport enthusiasts, there's an optional ski-pylon. A single Yamaha 300-hp engine pushes the boat to a top speed of 46.6 mph and 29.3 at cruise with a range of 312.6 miles.

Grady-White's all-new Freedom 235 (23'7" LOA, 8'6" beam) features the SeaV2® hull performance

(powered by a Yamaha 300-hp engine), which pushes the boat to a top end of 46.4 mph and 27.9 mph at cruise with a range of 204 miles. Features include built-in swim/boarding platforms port and starboard, two deck-level storage boxes, plenty of storage areas, and an oversized enclosed head with stowage for keeping rods, skis or toys. gradywhite.com
